FROM THE EDITOR'S CHAIR

A milestone year for Journal

The year 2000 is a significant one for the Manitoba Golf Association. This issue of the Journal marks the 21st year the MGA has published an annual magazine.

It all started back in 1980 when the MGA Council faced the prospect of losing the Manitoba Open Golf Championship due to a lack of sponsorship. Purses weren't large in those days and it was decided revenue could be obtained through a provincial golf yearbook to keep the event alive.

The Manitoba Golf Annual made its first appearance in the spring of 1980 and it provided some revenue to go into the Open pot. It helped to build the event back to a \$15,000 event after it had offered only \$5,500 in prize money the previous year and was in danger of falling by the wayside.

The Manitoba Golf Annual continued through nine issues under an MGA Yearbook Committee. It was changed in 1989 to become the Manitoba Golf Journal, published by Craig Kelman and Associates Ltd. Six issues were produced through to 1994.

In 1995, the contract to publish the Manitoba Golf Journal was taken over by Canadian Publishers and this marks the sixth annual publication to be produced from the St. James Street offices of Canadian Publishers, now known as Trans-

continental Distribution/Weeklies.

I have been involved in 15 of the 21 MGA publications, serving as the editorial director through the first nine years, then returning to handle the editorial consulting duties for the past six years.

The general appearance of this publication has undergone a few changes over the 21 years, but the basic premise remained the same. The objective has always been to present an annual yearbook to look back on the previous season's activities and look ahead to the season coming up, as well as providing a record of past records and a directory of the clubs which make up the Manitoba Golf Association.

In the 20 years since the first Manitoba Golf Annual was organized to save the Manitoba Open championship, we saw that tournament grow to become a major cog on the Canadian Tour as the Xerox Manitoba Open. It almost disappeared when the Tour decided to drop the event three years ago, but we can recall with pleasure that Jazz Golf came to the rescue in 1998. This will mark the third year for the Jazz Manitoba Open and also the 70th continuous Manitoba Open championship, the longest-running provincial open championship in the country.

We have many things to look forward to in 2000. The MTS Classic will continue to bring the Canadian Tour players to Winnipeg, moving from Elmhurst to return this year to Pine Ridge, where Rob McMillan pulled the big upset in winning as an

amateur in 1996. He'd be happy to repeat that result now in his third year as a professional on the tour.

We will also have an opportunity to see some of the golfing heroes of yesteryear when the AT&T Canadian Senior Open championship comes to St. Charles Country Club in August. Many golf fans are really looking forward to that one.

The Jazz Manitoba Open will be making a move this year after its first two years at the John Blumberg course. It will be played this year at the Transcona Golf Club and it will again offer the opportunity for the Manitoba professionals and amateurs to go head to head in an official competition.

New golf layouts will be opening this summer to expand the opportunities for Manitoba golfers to test their skills on a variety of courses, and there are some fine new clubhouses ready to greet the players. Details will be found on these pages and there will be much more said about them as the season progresses.

And, as usual, there has been some movement of personnel around the various pro shops and the superintendent quarters on the local golf scene. Again the details are on these pages.

The 2000 season got off to an early start with many golfers getting in their first licks before the end of March and most of us will be hoping it stretches well into the late fall before the snow chases us off.

Enjoy the season and don't forget to keep 'em on the fairways!

MEET THE MGA PRESIDENT

Rob MacDonald looks to raise golf profile

As Rob MacDonald takes over the reins as president of the Manitoba Golf Association, he hopes to see a higher profile for the sport in Manitoba through strong marketing and with the co-operation with the corporate sector.

At 43, MacDonald is among the younger presidents in the MGA history, but he's certainly not a newcomer when it comes to golf. He first got interested in the game as an 11-year-old at the Tuxedo Golf Course and he has been a member of the Elmhurst Golf and Country Club since his junior days at the age of 12.

A chartered accountant and a partner in Meyers Norris Penny, MacDonald has played golf for more than 30 years, but business pressure in recent years has curtailed some of his competitive activity. His handicap was as low as two a few years ago and he made it to the top 16 in Willingdon Cup team trials one year. He still plays to a handicap of six. His wife Karen is a relative newcomer to the game, but is showing enthusiasm.

He served as president of the Elmhurst club in 1991-92 and has been on the MGA Council since 1993. He was marketing chairman for two years and has been the association's president-elect and tournament chairmen for the past two seasons.

MacDonald looks for growing results from the Golf Manitoba marketing initiative, which was introduced

last year in conjunction with the Manitoba Ladies Golf Association.

"We hope to reach out to the corporate community for sponsorship of various programs and events," he said. "It's all part of our effort to raise the profile of golf in Manitoba. We want to assure we can continue to provide services and programs and become more self-sustaining."

He looks upon the corporate emphasis as a two-way street.

"Golf is still growing in this province and the corporate community can benefit from association with our sport," he said. "We are certainly expanding beyond the private clubs. We have been encouraged by the initial efforts last year and I expect there will be some major announcements in the marketing area this season."

MacDonald also looks forward to the first inductions into the Manitoba Golf of Fame scheduled in September. A project which was started by past-president Syd Coban three years ago, the first inductions were scheduled for June but have been set back to September.

The development of young golfers also rates high on the MacDonald agenda for golf success and he is proud of the MGA for leading the country by being the first provincial body to hire a full-time athlete development co-ordinator.

"Look at the fine showing we had from junior players last year in the Manitoba

Amateur and in the **Jazz Manitoba Open**," he said.

"We have a great crop of young juniors and it's a direct result of the program under **Garth Goodbrandson**. That program will be enhanced now, too, with some funding from the Sport Manitoba Legacy Trust to provide swing analysis equipment."

He also points to Manitoba being a test province for the RCGA's Future Links program and the fact the MGA was the first provincial organization to provide an annual golf publication in 1961 and the first to organize golf forums as further examples



of Manitoba's leadership.

MacDonald is happy with the response to the MGA/MLGA decision to offer some compensation this year to member clubs for the use of facilities in provincial tournaments. "This gives something back to the clubs that are hosting events and we have had good support," he said. "We must have participation from the member clubs to handle all our tournaments."

AMATEUR GOLFER OF THE YEAR

Finally, Garth Collings Wins

After playing the "bridesmaid" role five times in the past, Breezy Bend golfer **Garth Collings** finally got his chance to take the spotlight as he became the 1999 winner of the Manitoba Golf Association's Labatt Golfer of the Year award.

Collings was presented with the coveted trophy at the MGA annual meeting in November at the Bel Acres Golf Club, beating out 1999 provincial amateur champion **Adam Speirs** of St. Charles and provincial junior champion **Ryan Horn** of Dauphin for the honors.

It was ironic that the Golfer of the Year award, which had eluded him through several outstanding seasons, was finally won in a year when he experienced one of his worst performances in the provincial amateur championship.

He failed to earn a place on the Manitoba Willingdon Cup in 1999, but the 41-year-old Collings was on the provincial Mid-Amateur team and led the team at the national event, tying for third after 54 holes of medal play and losing out in the

round of 16 in match play.

Collings won the '99 Manitoba Amateur Tour championship by a wide margin, setting a course record at Sandy Hook (65) along the way. He also set a course record at Pinawa (69) to finish one stroke out of a three-way tie for the mid-amateur championship and earn the fourth spot on the team.

He won medal honors in the Manitoba Match Play championship and lost out in the semi-final round. He opened his 1999 season by winning his third straight Grey Owl tournament championship and he was the low amateur player in both the MTS Classic on the Canadian Tour and in the Jazz Manitoba Open.

Collings was also a finalist in Golfer of the Year voting in 1988, 1994, 1995, 1996 and 1998.

He lost out to **Dale Goehring** in 1988, the year Goehring won the Canadian juvenile championship. He lost out to **Rob McMillan** and **Aileen Robertson** in 1994, the year they both won national amateur honors and were joint winners of the

award. McMillan was again the winner in 1995 and 1996. In 1998, he lost out to **Terry Hashimoto**, who won three provincial championships.

It was a great relief for the popular Breezy Bend swinger to finally get his name on the Labatt trophy and it also won the approval of the crowd at the MGA annual meeting.

His opponents also had fine resumes for the 1999 season. Speirs, 21, was also a finalist in 1997. He was the Manitoba Amateur champion and leader of the Manitoba Willingdon Cup team.

Horn, a 17-year-old lefthander, was a runaway winner of the Manitoba Junior championship and also won the Rural junior honors. He was the leader on the provincial junior team and also finished fourth in the Manitoba Amateur championship to win a berth on the Willingdon Cup team. It was Horn's first time as a finalist.

Rule 14 -2, regarding assistance, has been amended to prohibit a caddie or partner from standing behind a player while he is making a stroke anywhere on the golf course. Previously, the prohibition only applied on the putting green.

HANDICAP

For 2000, a player's handicap index has been renamed a handicap "factor". Otherwise, there are no other changes to the handicap formula. For clubs using handicap software provided in 1999 by the MGA/RCGA, there will be a new software program for 2000.

The software used in 1999 was not Y2K compliant and accordingly the MGA/MLGA has purchased new software, which is being provided to clubs at no charge. The new software is

very similar to that used in 1999, which should result in minimal problems in adapting for players.

TOURNAMENTS

The basis of qualifying for the Ping Amateur Tour have been changed for 2000. Players who earned points on the 1999 Tour will be given the first opportunity to enter, after which, any player with a 5.0 handicap or less may enter. The field will be limited to 40 competitors and the Manitoba Amateur Championship and Jazz Manitoba Open no longer will be part of the Tour.

We will run a Junior Tour in 2000, with an objective of establishing a Junior Order of Merit at the conclusion of the

golf season.

We are currently finalizing arrangements for a Mixed Team Championship to be held in September. The format likely will be a modified two-person scramble.

The Manitoba Mid-Amateur Championship dates have been moved to the last week of July due to the RCGA moving the Canadian Championship to late August.

For 2000, the RCGA has gone to a quota system for the Canadian Amateur Championship. Manitoba

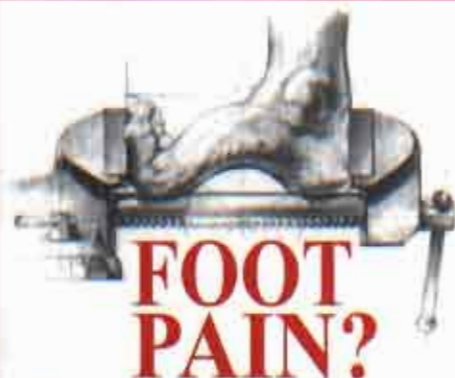

CPGA OF MANITOBA

A shuffling of pros on the Manitoba scene

The departure of two prominent Manitoba golf professionals at the conclusion of last season led to a major shuffling of the professional ranks in the province heading into the 2000 season. Several pros have been involved in the moves and golfers will find a number of new faces in the pro shops as the season gets under way.

John Irwin resigned his position as head pro at Niakwa last fall to try his hand at senior tournament golf in Europe and **Pat Kemball** left Pine Ridge to take up residence in California and that was the start of a domino-effect changing of positions.

Scott Dickson is a newcomer to the Manitoba scene, coming here from Quebec, where he was an associate professional at the Royal Montreal club, to take over the head pro position vacated by Irwin at the Niakwa Country Club.

Gord Workum took over the Kemball position as head pro at Pine Ridge Golf Club, leaving his post at the Kitchen Creek Golf Club in Fort Frances. **Steve Wood**, who left his post as head pro at South Interlake, has filled the opening at Kitchen Creek.

Another major head professional move saw **Wayne Meek** leave his position at Hecla Golf Course to take on head pro duties at the new Bridges Golf Club which will be opening this year at Starbuck, west of Winnipeg on Highway 2.

Two more newcomers to the Manitoba pro scene have arrived to fill the posts which had been held by Wood and Meek. **Garrett Burridge** comes here from Paris, Ont. to take

on head pro duties at South Interlake, while the Hecla head pro position has been taken by **Dave Gray**, who hails from Vancouver and served last season in the pro shop at Prince George.

Head professional **Derek Ingram** and associate pro **Dave McMillan** have joined forces to operate the new Golf Central driving range facilities, which opened in February on Plessis Road, just south of the Transcona Golf Club. McMillan was an associate pro at South Interlake last year, while Ingram was a tournament player on the Canadian Tour.

In Brandon, **Rich Bull** has taken over the management and there has been a name change for the former Brandon Recreation Centre Golf Club. It is now known as the Wheat City Golf Course, with Bull as the director of golf. **Gary Poole** stays with Bull to serve as the head pro and **Tyler Halls** will also be associated with the club as well as serving at the Northern Pines course which is part of the Taurus Golf operation. Bull also has two new apprentice pros in **Dave Scinocca** and **Gavin March**.

Also at Brandon, **Glen Mills** has moved in as an associate pro at the Deer Ridge Golf Club after serving in that capacity at Assiniboine Golf Club in 1999. **Bill Dinsdale** left Deer Ridge to take up duties as an assistant pro this year at Southwood Golf and Country Club.

Jason Ludke, who was an associate pro last year at St. Boniface Golf Club, has been appointed manager of the St. Boniface club and becomes an affiliate professional with the Manitoba Division of the CPGA.

On the distaff side, the local fans will continue to follow the LPGA Tour to lend some cheering support to **Gail Graham**, who plays out of Kelowna, BC, but learned her golfing talent as Gail Anderson at St. Charles Country Club. She's a former Manitoba amateur champion who turned professional in 1988 and has played since 1990 on the LPGA Tour.

What's new on the Manitoba Golf Scene

By RALPH BAGLEY

Manitoba golfers are always anxious to get going in a new golf season and they were finding a few new things to look forward to as the 2000 season got underway.

This season will see the opening of four new golf layouts in the Winnipeg area, four major new clubhouses and several other improvements, and the opening of a new practice facility, which kicked back in February.

The biggest new course on the horizon is the Bridges Golf Course,

which has been under construction the past couple of seasons at Starbuck on No. 2 Highway. It's a \$4.5-million project and officials have set a goal of Aug. 1 for the opening of the new full-size 18-hole course.

Another brand-new course in the offing is the Fantasy Lake Golf Club, an 18-hole par-three layout which has been constructed on No. 1 Highway, about two kilometers east of Deacon's Corner. Officials there have made July 1 their target date to get into the action.

The Executive Course, an 18-hole par-63/65 layout at the Southside Golf Center, which was announced last year, has been completed and an opening is planned for June 24.

The Towers Golf Course, an execu-

tive par-35 nine-hole course at Arnason's Driving Range, was actually opened for a couple weeks at the end of last year, but was officially opened at the start of this season in early April.

Throw in some planned course extensions in the coming months and it really gives the

Morse has hired **Wayne Meek**, formerly at Hecla Island, as the director of golf and the course superintendent is **Tony Feheregyhazi**, who has been involved with the construction of the course since leaving a superintendent post at Falcon Lake. **David Wagner** was the course architect.

The 18-hole par-72 course will feature four tee boxes on each hole and will play from a short 5000 yards on the front tees to a hefty 7250 yards from the back. There are six lakes on the course, providing about 28 acres of water and that water can come into play on about 15 of the

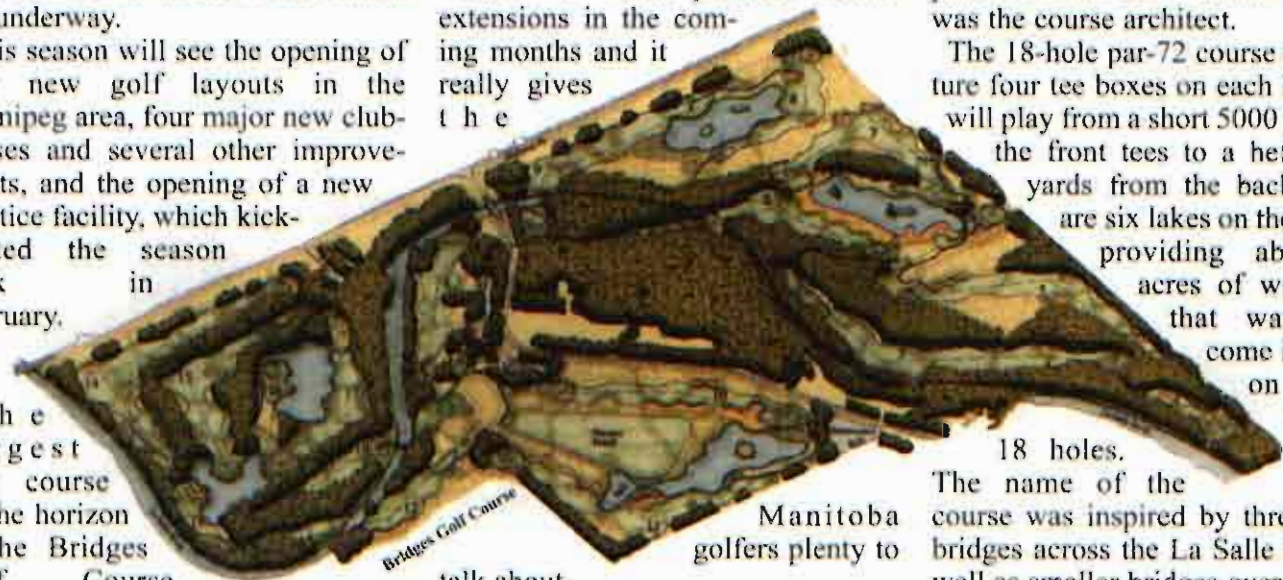
18 holes.

The name of the course was inspired by three major bridges across the La Salle River as well as smaller bridges over creeks.

Morse reports two-thirds of the course will feature tree-lined fairways with large oak trees predominant. The longest hole is a 530-yard par-five with a 90-degree dogleg right and the shortest hole will play about 110 yards from the front tee to 135 at the back.

In addition to the course, Meek will have full driving range and practice facilities to provide for lessons and golf workouts. A pro shop will be in operation this season while construction will get under way on the clubhouse to be opened in 2001.

When completed, the timber-frame clubhouse will cover about 10,000 square feet. It will feature an 80-seat lounge area, kitchen and locker facilities, two 40-seat meeting rooms and a 225-seat banquet hall. There will

talk about.

And, that's not all! Major new clubhouse construction has been going on through the winter and magnificent buildings are ready to serve the players at the Steinbach Fly-In club at Steinbach, the Kingswood Golf and Country Club at LaSalle and the Tuxedo Golf Course in Winnipeg. A fourth major clubhouse will be found at the new Bridges course at Starbuck.

BRIDGES GOLF COURSE

The location is on No. 2 Highway at Starbuck, just 11 kilometers west of Oak Bluff at the Perimeter Highway and officials emphasize that their new layout is an easy drive for Winnipeg golfers.

President and general manager **Bob**

also be decks for outdoor dining and full cart storage area under the building.

Morse reported total expenditure on the project will be close to \$4.5 million - about \$3.2 million on the course and \$1.1 on the clubhouse and he has set Aug. 1 as the target date for opening.

FANTASY LAKE GOLF CLUB

On the opposite side of Winnipeg, a few kilometers east of the Perimeter on No. 1 Highway is another new 18-hole golf course. Fantasy Lake is a layout of par-three holes which attracted attention as it was being constructed last year along the Trans-Canada Highway, about two kms east of Deacon's Corner, where the Lorette turnoff is located.

Ron and Jason Osadac and Ken and Jamie McCreedy are the owners of this project, which features one major lake and two ponds. The holes range from 105 to 160 yards in length and the course features plenty of water coming into play on the front nine and a links-type layout on the back nine. There will be an island tee on the fifth hole and an island green on the ninth.

A 1,200-square-foot clubhouse will be in use and Jamie McCreedy will serve as the pro-manager of the new facility with July 1 as the target date for opening.

THE EXECUTIVE COURSE

Tracy Kibsey and Wendy Mandryk made the initial announcement last spring and construction was carried out throughout the 1999 season on The Executive Course at their Southside Golf Center, which is located south of the Red River Floodway about one mile

east of Highway 59 on Carriere Road.

It's an 18-hole layout which features one par-five hole (531 yards) and the rest par-three and par-four to make up a men's par of 63 and women's par of 65. The shortest hole is 100 yards. Total course length is about 4,800 yards from the back tees.

An addition has been made to the Southside clubhouse, where Bunkers Bar and Grill will provide the food services. Tournament facilities will be available. A new larger clubhouse is in the future plans for the course. June 24 has been set as the target date for the opening.

TOWERS GOLF CLUB

When **Chuck Arnason** moved his Arnason's Driving Range from the northeast to the southwest corner of Waverley St. and Bishop Grandin Avenue, he decided to build a better nine-hole golf course to compliment his practice facility.

The Towers Golf Club was opened for a brief period at the end of last season and went into full operation as the 2000 season got under way. It's a par-35 links-type layout with four holes heading west from the clubhouse and five holes heading east to return. It features one par-five hole, two par-threes and the six par-fours. Length varies from 125 to 495 yards. Water comes into play on six of those holes. It's located alongside the power line and those towers provided the course name. Cart paths of crushed rock have been installed since the brief opening last fall.

At the driving range, Arnason has provided some new tee boxes and now features 10-12 teeing areas on grass and 20 on mats. There are target greens on the range and a 9,000-

square-foot green is available for chipping and putting.

GOLF CENTRAL

Professionals **Derek Ingram** and **Dave McMillan** got the jump on everyone else in the what's-new department back in February when they opened their Golf Central driving range operation on Plessis Road, just south of the Transcona Golf Club.

It's a year-round practice facility which features infrared gas heaters at the outdoor hitting stations, located in a structure which is open to the range area to the south. There are 22 bays with mats in the structure and in the summer months there will also be an outdoor area to hit from a grass tee.

A 10,000-square-foot putting green will also be available and a wedge range will provide a practice area for approach shots up to 100 yards.

Ingram, former head pro at South Interlake, spent the past two seasons on the Canadian Tour, while McMillan, who also had a year on the Tour, was an associate pro at South Interlake last season.

STEINBACH FLY-IN GOLF CLUB

The new clubhouse at Steinbach was opened in early April for the start of the 2000 season and head pro **Larry Robinson** and the rest of the Steinbach members are eager to show off the new facility. It's a timber-frame construction with large beams and a 26-foot vaulted ceiling and a mezzanine area.

The clubhouse covers 4,600 square feet, has a full basement and also features 3,000 square feet of outside decking on two levels, allowing vis-

itors to sit outside and watch play on the ninth hole.

The pro shop area covers about 900 square feet, almost triple the space Robinson had in the old building. There will be space to seat 150 in the restaurant and mezzanine areas. Showers and locker facilities will be featured in the basement, along with club storage. Robinson said total cost will amount to about \$600,000 including the furnishings and \$330,000 of that came from the club's fund-raising activities.

As a bonus, the Steinbach parking area is also to be paved, with completion expected by late May.

KINGSWOOD GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB

Executive pro and general manager **Gary Curtis** is also proud to show off the new clubhouse at the

Kingswood Golf and Country Club in LaSalle, which was also to open in mid-April, shortly after the club's early start of the new season.

The clubhouse is 8,500 square feet and there's a 2,500-square-foot canopy over the cart storage area, which houses a fleet of 60 motorized carts. The pro shop remains in a separate structure built two years ago behind the first tee, where head pro **Brad Keats** and his staff can be found.

A high vaulted ceiling is featured and the clubhouse will have three dining areas - a banquet room which can seat 250 people, a dining area for 60 and another patio dining area for 60. In addition, there will be seating for 150 on a deck on the west side of the building..

Included in the clubhouse will be a games room and washroom facilities featuring showers and some

locker space for day use.

TUXEDO GOLF COURSE

June 15 is slated for the completion of the new clubhouse at Tuxedo Golf Course and pro manager **Brock Balog** is also anxious to show off the new facility.

It features a tidy reception area leading to washrooms with shower and lockers. The restaurant area will seat 65 and an outdoor patio will accommodate up to 100 people. There is also a pro shop area of 800 square feet on the south side.

In addition to the new clubhouse, the entryway to the clubhouse and parking lot will be paved and there will be professional landscaping of the grounds.

Carol Doerksen takes the reins

Nineteen years ago, Carol Doerksen had little more than a passing interest in golf. She played a few games a year for recreational purposes and was far more serious about curling until back problems came along.

Then her brother, Cliff Dyck, encouraged Carol and husband Ed to join Southwood Golf and Country Club and, when they became members in 1981, a whole new summer lifestyle opened up.

I grew to love the game, the sociability, the competition and the friendly people at Southwood, she remembered.

During the day I was a banker, working in customer service and the training division with the TD Bank for 35 years. Golf became an ideal change of pace.

Doerksen soon developed a parallel interest in golf's administration. She was appointed to the MLGA executive board

in 1992-93 as assistant teams director under Joyce Collier. Seven years later, Doerksen took the presidential reins from Anne Leibl last September.

It's a challenge, but my family has grown up and I left the bank a year ago last January, she said. I now have the time to devote to it. Plus, I have some super directors to work with on the MLGA Board.

Carol made one proviso in accepting the position. Ed and I want to spend part of every winter in San Antonio playing golf, she said. The golf courses are a treat and it's a great break. And, with a competent executive director (Barb Leisle) looking after the association's business we have no problems.

Doerksen did have a problem to deal with heading home in early April - the resignation for personal reasons of junior development director Judith Barnes, who had trained for the position for two

years as assistant to Polly Weday. Weday later agreed to stay on as junior chairman for the 2000 season.

It's not the easiest director's job to fill, said Doerksen. You need special experience to handle it effectively.

Weday and Barnes had worked with MGA officials to produce a co-operative integration of the junior men's and women's tournaments last season.

Playing them together at the same time and courses was a natural, said Doerksen. I think it was the start of a closer liaison with the men's association.

Doerksen, 54, hopes to reach out to the club delegates in all MLGA districts as much as possible. This is the second year we've held a series of spring meet-

What's ahead for 2000?

One new champion is assured in women's golf in Manitoba in 2000 and the graduation of Niakwa's **Jill Hardy** from junior ranks may also pose a threat in the amateur category.

Hardy, now 19, was the first left-hander to win the Manitoba Junior Women's title in 31 years last season and really was head and shoulders above all opposition, winning by a whopping 31 strokes over 54 holes at Transcona and Rat River.

This year, Hardy will move up to challenge '99 champion **Angela Martens** of Southwood and the other mainstays in the amateur division July 17-19 at Rossmere's 5,992-yard par-73 layout.

Jo-Ann Lindsay of St. Charles is expected to shoot for an eighth provincial senior crown when the seniors and amateurs compete together and match their talents over 54 holes at Rossmere.

The Manitoba junior women's championship will again be combined with the first three days of the junior men's provincial championship, July 11-13 at Portage, Teulon and Elmhurst. **Kathleen Zeweniuk** of St. Boniface, who won in

1998, is still of junior age and should be a favorite.

Judi Lidstone of Elmhurst is the defending champion in the MLGA's other major event, the City and District championship. It will be re-instated as a 54-hole event July 4 at Morden's Minnewasta layout and July 5-6 at Breezy Bend.

"We'll be paying an honorarium of \$7 per golfer to the clubs for women's events and using their services for luncheons this year," said MLGA executive director **Barb Leisle**. "We know there's a cash crunch out there and this way we can do more to recognize the contributions of the host club."

The MLGA and MGA will follow this honorarium procedure for all tournaments in 2000, although a lower fee, \$250 total per day, will apply to accommodate junior events.

By combining the junior provincials, the MLGA and MGA will continue a joint organizational plan and this year the tournament and officiating committees will be integrated for the junior event. The process guarantees that more entries for junior women are encouraged and will be accepted.

The MLGA's Advanced Development Program will become more self-directed on a trial basis this season. The 11 leading amateurs and seniors, all who applied, will provide more input and may direct their own improvement plan. They will create their own focus, track their progress and make quarterly reports.

Those enrolled are amateurs **Angela Martens, Jill Hardy, Judi Lidstone, Tammy Gibson, Susan MacKenzie, Donna Brownridge** and **Raegan Wilkie** plus seniors **Eadie Stephenson, Bonnie Stephenson, Pat Fusee** and **Annette Durica**.

The MLGA's marketing agent, DCB Productions, is developing a Manitoba golf promotional package to offer to sponsors. At this point, team clothing and volunteer shirts are provided by Intrepid Dezine and golf bags for the provincial teams are donated by Jazz Golf Equipment.

All national women's championships are in Atlantic Canada this year, but Manitoba will be in the spotlight in 2001, when Southwood plays host to the Canadian Junior and Niakwa is the site for the CLGA National Amateur Championship.

ings at different locations in April, she pointed out. We had Carman, Selkirk, Swan River, Brandon, Pinawa, Winnipeg, Thunder Bay and Fort Frances on the schedule. In the smaller group environment our communication is much better.

The MLGA is distributing new guidance manuals to sports captains and women executives at member clubs. Prepared under the supervision of vice-president **Barbara Fenton**, the manuals are intended to offer instruction in the set-up for golf events and tournaments at the club level.

A new tournament will welcome golfers within the association's jurisdiction in Districts G and H this season. The Northwestern Ontario Amateur, Senior and Junior Championships will be inaugu-

rated Aug. 22 at the Eagles Landing club in Dryden.

We hope it will prove to be as popular as our combined Rural Amateur, Senior and Junior tournament scheduled for July 24 in Steinbach this year, Doerksen said.

On the downside, we lost the National Club Teams Championship (NCTC) this year, she admitted. There just wasn't enough participation at the club level to justify Revlon's sponsorship. The CLGA would like to replace it with another type of tournament, maybe in 2001.



The MGSA will combine with Landscape Manitoba to present a Turfgrass Conference in November. A special association golf tournament is being planned during the summer for the members and the staffs of the course superintendent crews.

Originally named the Golf Course Superintendents Association of Manitoba, the organization was founded Oct. 25, 1950, at Glendale Country Club, with Cy Creed of Niakwa as the first president. The name was changed and a modern logo was adopted in 1996.

The objectives have remained throughout the 50 years. The MGSA is committed to providing education for its members and the golfing public for the preservation and enhancement of golf courses and their environments within Manitoba.

Derek Holbrow of the Charleswood Golf Club is in the second year of his presidency, supported by vice-president Darryl Mistelbacher of Elmhurst Golf and Country Club, past president Rob Hamm of the Carman Golf Club and directors Roy Dokuchie of Assiniboine Golf Club, Tony Feheregyhazi of the Bridges Golf Course at Starbuck, Mark Jordan of Bel Acres Golf and Country Club, Dave Turner of Falcon Beach Golf Course and Kevin Welch, commercial representative from Brandt Industries. Bob Hamm of Steinbach is the executive director.

Only a few changes have been reported in the membership in the past year. Mark Jordan has moved from an assistant post to become head superintendent at Bel Acres Golf and Country Club. Tim Gould has moved to the Oakview Golf Club at Altona as head superintendent after serving as an assistant at Breezy Bend.

Scott Ramsay has taken on head superintendent duties at the Pinawa Golf Club after serving at the Souris-Glenwood course at Souris.

Holbrow said members of the association have been generally pleased with the condition of local golf courses this spring.

"We were a little worried about the lack of snow this past winter could cause some trouble, but the poa grass has come through better than I've ever seen," he remarked, noting that most Manitoba greens feature the poa grass.

"The greens are in better shape than usual for early in the season," he added. "The ground seemed to freeze well and not too deep. There wasn't much snow mould and there was very little ice damage reported."

The early start to the 2000 season, with some courses open for play before the end of March, has cut down on the spring preparation time for the superintendents. There was a short transition period from the winter preparations of the fall to the uncovering of greens and moving into full play this year.

"In my 12 years on golf courses, this is the earliest start I can remember," said Holbrow. "I recall in the spring of 1988 we had all the covers off the greens in the first week of April, but I can't recall any seasons starting earlier in my time."

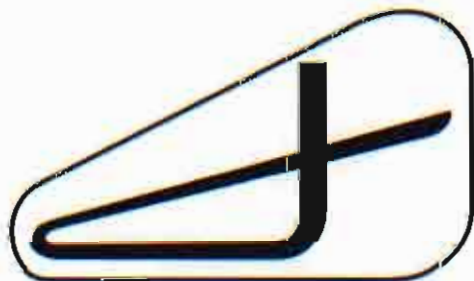

Three major events for golf fans

Manitoba golf fans are in for a special treat this summer with three major events on the calendar and a chance to make many comparisons.

The feature attraction will be the AT&T Canadian Senior Open championship, which will bring the PGA Senior Tour players to St. Charles Country Club Aug. 7-13. Officials are hoping to attract most of the leading players from the Senior Tour to this event. Local fans are particularly hoping they'll get a chance to see players like **Tom Watson** and a few others in their first year of senior competition along with the older standbys.

We can't expect all of the stars from the PGA Senior Tour, but the Canadian event is becoming an established stop and the fact the St. Charles event will come right after a stop in the Twin Cities should make it an easy trip north to play here.

The first major attraction for the local golf fans will be the annual Canadian Tour stop in Winnipeg. This year the venue for the MTS Classic moves across the road from Elmhurst to Pine Ridge and the event has also been moved up a week on the calendar, running from June 29 to July 2.

The move back to Pine Ridge should be encouraging to local pro **Rob McMillan**, who calls the Ridge his home course. That's where he stunned the Tour regulars back in 1996 when he was still an amateur and came on top of the field. Now in his fourth year as a pro on the Tour, McMillan will certainly have sentiment with him this time around. Of course, **Todd Fanning**, the other Manitoban on the Canadian Tour, will also be trying to impress the local fans.

And, it's always interesting to see how many of the local players can get their game going well enough to make

the cut and provide added interest for the fans. Those same fans have learned over the years that the top players on the Canadian Tour are not too far away from making it to the Big Show - the PGA Tour. In fact, there are a few Canadian Tour grads well up on the leader boards most weeks.

The third major event for the local fans will be played Aug. 24-26 when the Jazz Manitoba Open championship moves this season to Transcona after two years at John Blumberg. It's the third year for the tournament under the title sponsorship of Jazz Golf, and this marks the 70th consecutive year there has been a Manitoba Open golf championship.

The main attraction in this one is to the chance to see the Manitoba professionals and amateurs test their games against each other. Both the pros and amateurs expressed pleasure at the opportunity in the past two years and the rivalry should continue to make this an interesting event for local spectators.

Those are the major spectator events, but golf fans can also see interesting competition if they take in the provincial amateur championships, both male and female, and

also when the local pros play their provincial championship events. The players will appreciate the attention, too.

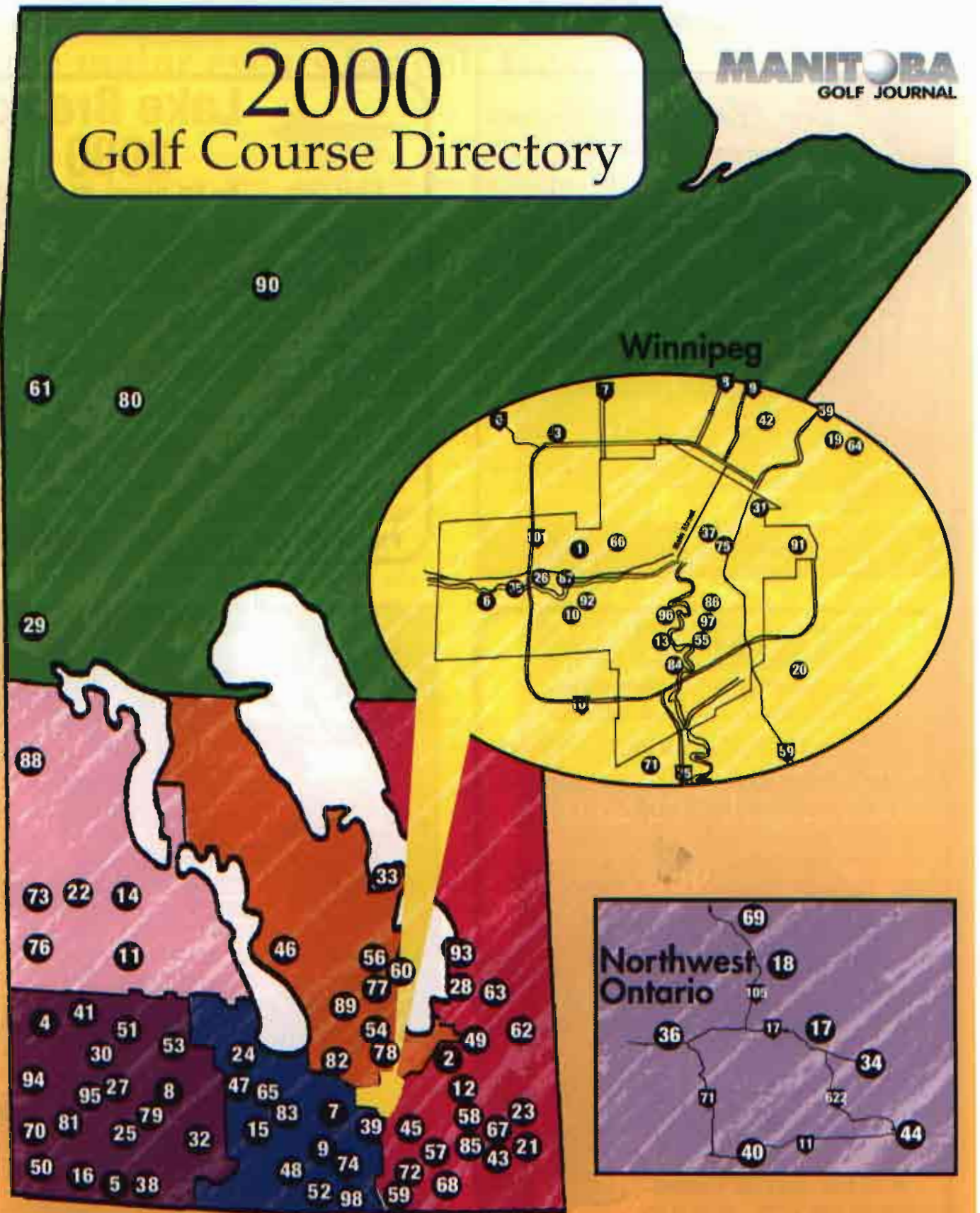

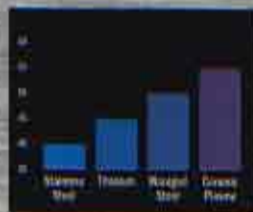
