



Application procedures to serve on the Alberta Golf Board of Directors

Last updated November 1, 2020

Two application methods have been approved for processing candidates for service on Alberta Golf Association's (Alberta Golf) Board of Directors (Board):

- One method is for individuals known to the Board by way of their volunteer* service on Alberta Golf's operating committees and/or as a volunteer with the Alberta Golf Association Foundation (Foundation);
- The other method is for individuals whose community service and/or corporate work is in areas directly related to Alberta Golf operational committees.

Procedures

1. Names of volunteers known to the Board by way of their service on Alberta Golf's operational committees are submitted by members of the Nominating Committee and listed for future reference. Individuals will be contacted by a Nominating Committee member with regard to their interest in serving on the Board. Should the individual express interest, he/she will be asked to complete an application form to include:
 - i. updated contact information
 - ii. additional skill sets (e.g. recent degrees, certificates, awards etc.)
 - iii. a statement of why he/she wants to serve on the BOD and how their specific Knowledge, Skills and Abilities (KSA's) can assist Alberta Golf in accomplishing its stated goals and objectives
 - iv. how much time he/she can commit to BOD service
2. Individuals known to the BOD by way of their community and/or corporate work in areas directly related to Alberta Golf's operational committees are required to:
 - i. complete the Alberta Golf Volunteer Application process
 - ii. be interviewed, usually by phone, by members of the BOD Nominating Committee
 - iii. be recommended to the BOD

BOD position openings are posted on the Alberta Golf and Foundation websites. Postings may be "continuous", or they may be specific with a set opening and closing date.

** Volunteer is an individual that has been vetted by and accepted for service through the Alberta Golf volunteer application process.*
