



NEXTGEN SUPER CAMP – Selection Criteria

Prerequisites

- Must be a Canadian citizen and hold a Canadian passport.
- Must not have reached their 17th birthday as of January 1st, 2020
- Must have a Golf Canada Membership, and unquestioned status as an amateur golfer.
- Must be a member in good standing with Golf Canada and not subject to any disciplinary process or sanction of the Association.

Selection Process

1. Athletes will be selected for the 2020 Spring Super Camp at the conclusion of the 2019 Canadian Junior Girls and Canadian Junior Boys' championships.
2. Invitations are earned by achieving two (2) of the age specific results listed below:

3. A selection committee, comprised of the Chief Sport Officer, Manager, High Performance Sport, Head Coach, National Junior Boys' Squad, and Head Coach, National Junior Girls' Squad, may select additional players beyond those who qualify. Such determinations will be based on:
 - Recommendation from Provincial Golf Association
 - Golf Canada tracking, monitoring, and evaluation and ranking
 - Results in National, NextGen, and Provincial Championships
 - Ability to achieve LTPD benchmarks including (but not limited to):
 - Stroke average
 - Tournament handicap
 - Ball speed
